

Could you recognise the early signs of heart failure in your dog?



About 1 in 10 dogs seen by vets is suffering from heart disease.¹ Common signs and symptoms of congestive heart failure in dogs include:

- Coughing, especially at night
- Reluctance to exercise, with dog tiring more easily
- Fainting – often associated with exercise
- Laboured or fast breathing
- Poor appetite
- Weight loss
- Enlarged abdomen
- Weakness.
